OPD 301: meant for current and prospective COs & XOs; CAPT Bruni will be on hand to instruct.

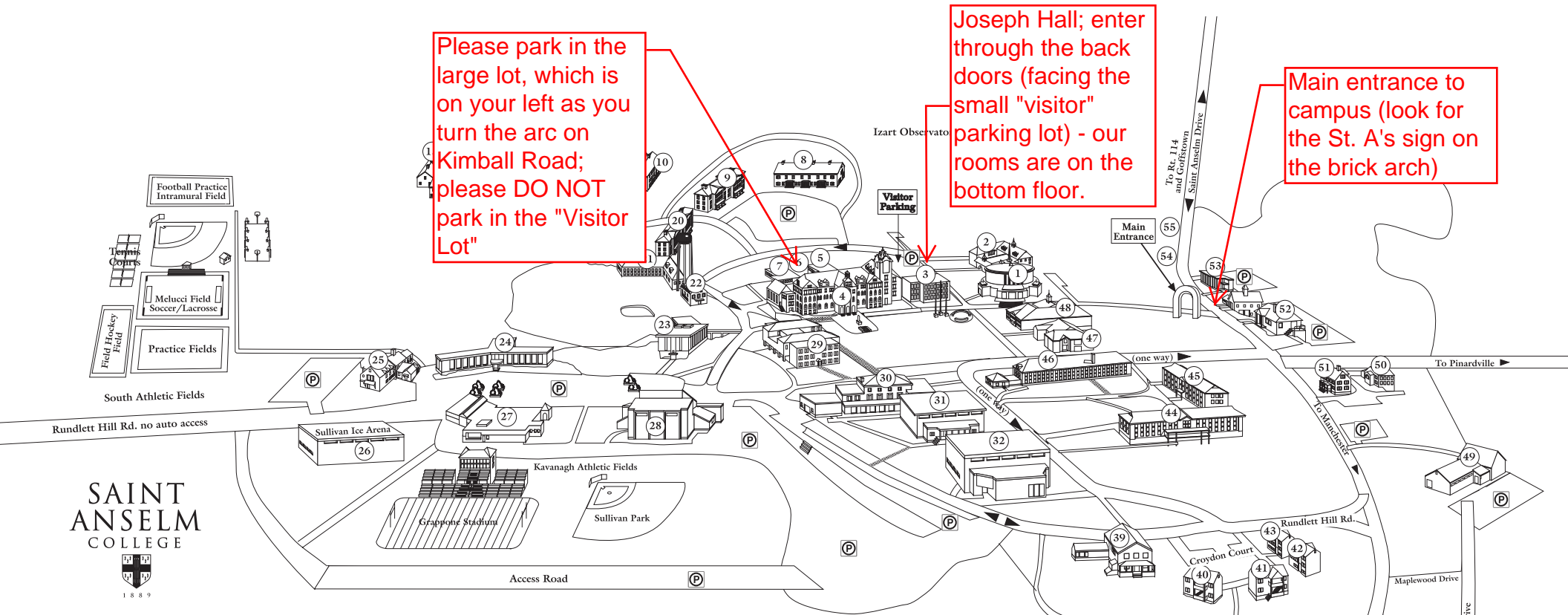
Registration: **All registration will take place via Magellan;** ask your Unit CO or Training Officer to register you ASAP!

Per Diem: A \$45 per diem will be paid to enrolled NSCC officers, instructors, and midshipmen who attend an OPD course to cover your travel expenses. In order to receive your per diem payment, you must:

- 1) carry a current NSCC enrollment
- 2) register for the appropriate course on Magellan
- 3) print and present your NSCTNG006 (Training Authority) upon arrival
